1. Tournaments

2. Double Ranking Point Tournaments

Multiple ranking points from the Australian Ranking List will not apply to the Reventon Rankings. All events will carry single ranking points.

3. Points earned

Nominating and playing in a tournament	5 points
Round of 64 – win or receive forfeit	2 points
Round of 32 onwards – each frame won or receive by forfeit	1 point
Round of 32 onwards – win or receive forfeit	5 points

Bonus points will be awarded for: -

Each break of 100 or more	5 points
Losing Quarter-finalist	5 points
Losing Semi-finalist	10 points
Runner-up	20 points
Winner	40 points
Any unseeded player defeating a 1-8 seeded player	10 points
Any unseeded player defeating a 9-16 seeded player	5 points

4. Ranking Positions

The Ranking positions will be calculated from points received for the 6 largest points totals from events contested. Players must compete in at least 6 Reventon Ranking Events to qualify for the Reventon Rankings Finals.
