There is a weekly fee of \$7.00 per player per match, calculated and invoiced at end of each season. The VBSA do not charge Juniors (under 18 at Jan 1st 2019) or Life Members the \$7 per week to participate in the Pennant or Willis Seasons. Please notify the Score Registrar by email to scores@vbsa.org.au if you have Junior Player(s) in your team, so we can ensure invoicing is correct at the end of the season. If you do not notify the VBSA, you may be invoiced the full amount.

VBSA Membership is now included in your weekly playing fee of \$7 per player per week (invoiced at the end of the season).

Definition of a member – A person is considered a financial member when they

- Have been granted Life Membership OR
- Have played or refereed at least 1 match in either Season 1 (S1) or Season 2 (S2) in the current year OR
- Have paid the appropriate fee (for tournament play, where a player is not playing weekly *) AND
- Have completed, lodged and had approved a Membership Application. Download Application [HERE](#).

* For the purposes of Tournament play, as both Victorian and Interstate tournaments require entrants to be a member of their home state association, in the early part of the year any player that was a member in the previous year will be considered a member for this purpose only. As the year progresses, a player will need to either be playing on a regular basis or pay the nominated membership fee to enter tournaments

In 2019, ALL grades will be limited to a maximum of 10 teams

ALL Captains and Players are urged to familiarise themselves with the VBSA ByLaws, which govern the conditions of Pennant Play. In particular, you are urged to conform to

- **Section 2 – Dress Regulations**
- **Section 7 - Matches**
- **Section 9 – Player Regulations**

Captains are expected to ensure their players have read and understood these ByLaws.
