

VBSA SURVEY NOV/DEC 2017 – RESULTS

A total of 131 responses were received, which is a great sample from the 400+ VBSA membership. Where totals differ from 131, this is due to there being more than one answer permitted to a particular question or where an answer has not been given.

Breakdown against any question by Grade/Season played or age can be provided on request. It is only shown here for Questions 3 & 4 due to the high interest.

Q1. DRESS CODE. For ALL finals, would you prefer	125 Answered
Team/Club Polo Shirt. If preferred, the shirts must be mandatory and must be identical.	66 (52.8%)
No change	59 (47.2%)
	VBSA. Responses were split almost 50-50. The Board received constructive feedback explaining complications associated with team polos (e.g. some players would have to buy multiple polos) and describing the experience of other sports that have introduced team polos. Consequently, the Board decided not to switch to team polos. Home & Away attire is to remained unchanged.

	VBSA. The highest support was for team polos, and 85% voted for one of the two options that are less formal. Based on the experience of billiards ranking tournaments (where Home & Away attire is worn) and the decision not to introduce team polos for Home & Away matches, the Board decided to adopt Home & Away attire for these snooker tournaments.
