Match schedule and refereeing duties

Please study the attached match schedule to check when you will be playing and note when you will be required to referee. There will be a 15 minute break between matches to provide time for referees to brush and block tables and complete score sheets.

Players who are late for the start of their match will give 100 points start to their opponent. Players who are more than 15 minutes late will forfeit the match.

The VBSA will provide a number of referees for the event. Players will be required to referee matches in accordance with the match schedule.

Please check the schedule to see which table you are refereeing on. The referee is responsible for filling in the scoresheet and setting up the scoreboard. At the conclusion of the match the referee is responsible for completing the scoresheet, obtaining the players' signatures, brushing and blocking the table and returning the completed scoresheet and name tags to the office.

Dress code

As per ABSC championship dress code. Bow ties are required for all matches. Waistcoats are required from the quarter finals onwards.
