Conditions of play and tournament rules

- All players must report to the Tournament Director or his Deputy on arrival.
- All players are expected to be in attendance at least 15 minutes before the start of their scheduled games.
- Any player not in attendance and ready to play at the designated start time will lose one (1) frame when the referee calls the game to commence.
- If a player is not in attendance 15 minutes after the designated start time or when the referee calls the game to commence, his/her game shall be declared a walkover given to his/her opponent. If both players are in default of being absent after the aforesaid grace period of 15 minutes, both players will be declared in default and their game deemed a walkover with no frames or points awarded to either player.
- All Matches on Sunday will be refereed at no cost to players.
- All disputes will be referred to the Tournament Director and/or Director of Referees and their decision will be final.
- Dress Code: National Ranking Dress Code Applies to this Tournament.
- The tournament will be conducted under the ABSC playing conditions. All matters pertaining to the players code will be adhered to.
