



All entrants must be outside top 32 as per [Australian Rankings](#) & never won a State Title or considered a "Top Tier" player will be permitted to play in this event. Final decisions will be left to the discretion of the Tournament Director

1. National Rankings current as of close of entries will be considered before accepting entries.
2. All matches leading up to the quarter finals will be self-refereed. A roaming VBSA referee will be available to assist.
3. "If required, a field of 52 or greater will result in 1st round matches commencing at 7pm on the Friday.
4. All matches throughout the event will be best of 5. The final will be best of 7.
5. Quarter final matches will commence on the Sunday at 10am
6. Semi-finalists and onwards must be present at final presentation to receive prize money.
7. State pennant minimum dress code applies: Neat trousers/pants/skirt/dress, a collared T-shirt or polo. A long sleeve shirt and shoes must be worn on the Sunday.
8. A 15 Red Line-Up Challenge will take place during the event. Entry is \$5 (paid on the day). All entrants will have 1 x 60 second attempt to pot as many reds as possible. In the case of a tie there will be a play off. The winner will receive 80% of the pot.
9. Main event prize money is subject to number of entries.
